To correct the previous notice the Pacific Coast Yachting Association is pleased to announce that it has accepted three new nominations and retained for consideration two nominees from 2006 for the 2007 Charles A. Langlais award. Nominees are:

Southern California Cruisers Association (SCCA) nominates Craig Ryan of both the Hollywood Yacht Club and Shoreline Yacht Club

Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) has nominated Jerry Martin of the King Harbor Yacht Club.

San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs (SDAYC) has nominated Bruce Green of the San Diego Yacht Club.

San Diego Cruiser Association (SDCA) has nominated Jim Lonergan of Southwestern Yacht Club

Santa Monica Bay Power Fleet (SMBPF) has nominated Bruce Kessler of the Del Rey Yacht Club.

The judging panel, co-chaired by last years Langlais recipient Stan Honey and PCYA's Vice Commodore will recommend a candidate for the award to be voted upon by the PCYA Board and announced at the general meeting of PCYA in San Diego on January 26, 2008.

The Trophy consists of a sterling silver loving cup mounted on a teak base bearing plaques for the names of the several recipients. It will be displayed at the Yacht Club of the recipient during the year following the award. An appropriate take-home trophy will be provided for the individual honored by this award.

Charles A. Langlais first won this trophy in 1926 sailing the R Boat, LADY GAY in the 1926 Championship Regatta of the Pacific Coast Yachting Association. PCYA Staff Commodore Langlais rededicated it in 1976 to be awarded once in any calendar year to an individual for "exceptional, outstanding and meritorious service to the sport of yachting".
