

**PACIFIC COAST YACHTING ASSOCIATION INCLUSIVE SAILING AWARD
FOR RACING AND PARTICIPATION**

DEED OF GIFT

The undersigned hereby presents to the Pacific Coast Yachting Association a perpetual trophy to be awarded each year under the conditions set forth below, and to be known as the:

Pacific Coast Yachting Association Inclusive Sailing Award for Racing and Participation

I. ELIGIBILITY

Contestants shall be boats in an Inclusive Sailing Fleet, skippered by a person defined disabled by the Americans with Disabilities Act. The boats shall satisfy the requirements for racing and the Regatta shall follow the current United States Sailing *the Racing Rules of Sailing*.

II. CONTEST

The trophy shall be awarded on the basis of participation and scoring in One (1) Inclusive Sailing Regatta per year to be determined by the Current Rear Commodore or designated representative of the Pacific Coast Yachting Association. An effort shall be made to rotate the Regatta's that are scheduled and run by the Yacht Clubs and Members of the Pacific Coast Yachting Association.

III. SCORING

In each race, the first boat to finish shall receive 3-1/4 points, the second boat shall receive 2 points, and the third boat shall receive 1 point. In addition, each boat starting shall receive 2 points and each boat finishing shall receive 8 additional points. The boat accumulating the greatest number of points under the above scoring system shall be awarded the trophy for that year. In the case there is more than one Inclusive Sailing fleet, the scoring formula shall be applied to all divisions of the Inclusive Sailing Fleets racing in the Regatta. In order for all the divisions to be scored on an equal number of races, a Pacific Coast Yachting Association flag officer or designated representative of the Pacific Coast Yachting Association, shall throw out the lowest scored races of the division(s) that finished more races to equal the number of races scored for all of the divisions and then compute the points earned by the competitors to determine the winner.

IV. TROPHY

The perpetual Trophy's Base shall be engraved and presented to the Host Club at the event. The holder of the Trophy shall return it to Pacific Coast Yachting Association prior to the Annual (PCYA) Installation meeting. Additionally, the Pacific Coast Yachting Association shall engrave the Trophy's Base with the winners name and present the winner with a keeper plaque at the Annual Installation and Awards Meeting.
